#### EXHIBITORS ARE REQUIRED TO CLEAN UP AFTER THEIR DOGS

All entries must be at least 6 months of age or older on the day of the Trial, and be ASCA® registered, or apply and pay for an ASCA Tracking Number.

You may be asked to show proof of registration.

\*\*No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disgualified from any ASCA program; or a person not in good standing with ASCA.

ALL ASCA® RULES WILL BE FOLLOWED

NOTE TO PERFORMANCE COMPETITORS: THIS IS NOT A MATCH. All dogs will be competing for obedience titles through ASCA®. Each entry form must have a current registration number (ASCA® or recognized registry) and be completely filled out, no exceptions. If your dog has earned a title through any other registry, but not ASCA®, your dog will be required to begin in Novice.

\*\* All non-ASCA® registered dogs will be required to have an ASCA® Tracking Number if you wish to earn ASCA titles. This is a one-time fee of \$20.00 per dog. At the time of applying for the tracking number, the individual owner must also be an ASCA® member (Service member fee-\$20.00). ASCA® membership does not need to be maintain in subsequent years. You will be able to apply for a tracking number the day of the show, if your dog does not have one.
